

Indoor Range Rules of the Massapoag Sportsmen's Club

A. FIREARMS ALLOWED ON THE RANGE

1. Handguns.
2. Rifles chambered in .22 rimfire only.
3. Air pistols and air rifles (with pellets only); 'BB' guns are NOT allowed.
4. Fully automatic firearms, shotguns, and black powder pistols and rifles, are NOT allowed.

B. AMMUNITION

Acceptable

1. Lead, alloy, jacketed, and semi-jacketed bullets are allowed.
2. Pellet guns are allowed.

Disallowed

1. Rifle calibers other than .22 rimfire are NOT allowed for use in rifles on the Indoor Range.
2. 'BB's are NOT allowed.
3. Jacketed magnum ammunition is NOT allowed.
4. Shotshells and slugs are NOT allowed – IE: No use of shotguns on the indoor range.

C. TARGETS

1. Paper targets only.
2. No targets larger than 10 1/2" x 12" are allowed.
3. Target distance from the firing line shall be set as follows:
 - a. At Stations 1, 5, and 12, targets shall be set at 50' only.
 - b. At Stations 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 13 and 14, targets may be set between 25' and 50'.
 - c. Station 8 is not in use. This location is used for access to downrange for inspection/cleaning.

D. GENERAL RULES

1. The Indoor Range is to be used only by "qualified members" (those with card keys) and their guests.
2. Members must have their Indoor Range card key worn visibly when using the range. Do not loan your card key to anyone.
3. Members and guests must sign in / sign out of range, listing: Time IN, Time OUT, and noting the condition of the range. Members are liable for their guests.
4. Members with guests may share up to two (2) shooting stations, provided no members are waiting.
5. The hours of operation are twenty-four (24) hours a day, 365 days a year, except during work details, scheduled shooting events, and fifteen minutes prior to and during scheduled club meetings.
6. Lights must be turned on when shooting.
7. Exhaust fans must be turned on while any person is on the range.
8. If you are the last person to leave the range / Clubhouse, turn off all the lights and exhaust fans.
9. No smoking or eating is allowed on the indoor range.
10. All members and guests are expected to clean their areas after shooting. All spent ammunition should be picked up and the floor swept before vacating the premises. All spent ammo should be placed in the recycling bins.
11. All socializing is to be confined to the meeting area. The indoor range is for shooting only.
12. Specific rules / procedures will be posted, and followed, during any club sponsored pistol / rifle events.
13. Dud rounds are to be placed in the dud container provided.
14. No drawing of the firearm from the holster, including quick draw etc.
15. No loaded firearms behind the red lines on the bench of the shooting station.
16. Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times.
17. All firearms are to be unloaded with the action open when not in use at a station unless properly holstered.

NOTE: Properly holstered hand guns and pistols - whether concealed or unconcealed - are allowed on club property with the exception of the skeet & trap fields. However, all guns shall remain holstered at all times except when on the firing range shooting station.

Outdoor Range Rules of the Massapoag Sportsmen’s Club

A. FIREARMS ALLOWED ON THE RANGE

1. All rimfire rifles and centerfire rifles only in the calibers listed below.
2. Handguns.
3. Air pistols and air rifles (with pellets or BB’s).
4. Fully automatic firearms are NOT allowed.
5. Rifles chambered for traditional pistol calibers or Black Powder Flintlock / Percussion rifles are allowed on the Outdoor Range.

B. AMMUNITION

Acceptable

1. Only centerfire rifles in the following pistol calibers are allowed:
.22rimfire - all (.22LR, .22 Short, .22 Long, .22 Magnum, etc), .17rimfire, .32, .32-20, .32 H&R Mag, .30 Carbine, 38 Special, .357 Magnum, 9mm, .40, .44 Special, .44 Magnum, .45 Long Colt, .38-40, .44-40
2. Lead, alloy, jacketed, and semi-jacketed bullets are allowed. No tracer or armor piercing ammunition is allowed.

Disallowed

1. All shot shells and slugs are NOT allowed – IE: No use of shotguns on the outdoor range.
2. All centerfire rifle cartridges with the exception of those listed in ‘Acceptable’ list above.

C. TARGETS

1. Paper targets only.
2. No targets larger than 10 1/2" x 12" are allowed.
3. Targets must be hung from the cross-beams, (on the available target hangers). Targets shall not be attached directly to the cross-beams or support columns, or hung such that they overlap the support columns.
4. Other special targets may be used after obtaining approval of the Board of Directors for special club shooting activities.

D. GENERAL RULES

1. The hours of operation are 10:00 a.m. until sunset. [Sunset is defined by the National Weather Service].
2. Members and guests must sign in / sign out of range, listing: Time IN, Time OUT, and noting the condition of the range. Members are liable for their guests.
3. Members with guests may share up to two (2) shooting stations, provided no members are waiting.
4. The outdoor range will be CLOSED during any scheduled Skeet and Trap competitions.
5. Specific rules / procedures will be posted and followed during any club sponsored pistol / rifle events.
6. All members and guests are expected to clean their areas after shooting. All spent ammunition should be picked up and the floor swept before vacating the premises. All spent ammo should be placed in the recycling bins.
7. Dud rounds are to be placed in the dud container provided.
8. No drawing of the firearm from the holster, including quick draw etc.
9. No loaded firearms behind the red lines on the bench of the shooting station.
10. Eye and ear protection must be worn at all times.
11. All firearms are to be unloaded with the action open when not in use at a station unless properly holstered.
